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Dental Coverage For Pregnant Women Enrolled in Medicaid and FAMIS MOMS Fact Sheet

Background	<p>Governor Terry McAuliffe's <i>A Healthy Virginia</i> is a 10-step plan to increase healthcare services to over 200,000 Virginians. This plan includes ways to provide dental care to pregnant women enrolled in Virginia's Medicaid program.</p> <p>Beginning March 1, 2015, Virginia's Smiles For Children program will provide dental benefits to pregnant women age 21 and over in Medicaid and FAMIS MOMS.</p>
Purpose	<p>Dental coverage for pregnant women enrolled in Medicaid or FAMIS MOMS will assist in improving the oral health of the mother and aid in the delivery of a healthy baby.</p>
Services Offered	<p>Starting March 1, 2015, dental services for pregnant women enrolled in Medicaid and FAMIS MOMS will include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ X-rays and examinations➤ Cleanings➤ Fillings➤ Root canals➤ Gum related treatment➤ Crowns, bridges, partials and dentures➤ Tooth extractions and other oral surgeries, and➤ Other appropriate general services <p>Orthodontic treatment is not included in the coverage.</p>
Service Requirements and Limitations	<p>Pregnant women will need to provide the dentist with the anticipated due date.</p> <p>The dental coverage for Medicaid enrolled women who are pregnant includes coverage for 60 days after the baby is born.</p> <p>Pregnant women will be able to access non-emergency transportation services to receive dental care. Transportation for pregnant women who are enrolled in a managed care organization (MCO) with the exception of those enrolled in FAMIS, will be provided by the MCO. Contact the MCO to make arrangements.</p> <p>Transportation for pregnant women in fee for service will be provided by LogistiCare.
